

TRASHION COMPETITION RULES

Space Center Houston and the No Impact Project have partnered to bring you an Earth Day event filled with educational activities and family-fun. The purpose of Trashion Contest is to enhance participants' understanding of sustainability through repurposing.

1. Students/designers are invited to create an original garment using “trash”—recycled products.
2. The entries should not contain any profanity, vulgarity, or offensive messages. All entries must be school appropriate or they will be disqualified.
3. Contestants may enter as individuals, pairs or teams. The design must be the contestant's original work.
4. Each Trashion entry should be brought to Space Center Houston (1601 NASA Parkway, Houston, TX 77058) on April 19, 2014 along with the contestants' entry form.
5. Student designers will model their garments at Space Center Houston's No Impact Day on April 19, 2014.
6. **Please visit <http://spacecenter.org/noimpactchallenge/> to download and complete your entry form. All entry forms must be received by April 7, 2014. Fashion pieces will be featured in the runway show on April 19, 2014 at Space Center Houston.**
7. Winners will be announced on the day of the event. Awards will be determined by the design quality, originality, and overall appearance. Educational grants will be awarded to the winning entry.
