

## Day Camp Information

### What to do at check in:

**Precare:** 7:00-8:15am. Follow instructions listed below. Remember to give your camper breakfast before bringing them to SCH or bring breakfast with you.

**When you arrive at Space Center Houston:** Arrive between 8:15-8:30 a.m. afternoon 4 year olds arrive between 12:15-12:30 p.m.

☆ Enter Space Center Houston's main entrance and pass through the toll gate. Park your car in the front of the main entrance to the center. The registration cart will be set up just inside the main entrance doors. **For your child's safety all campers must be checked in by an adult.**

1. Check in your camper(s) and inform us if someone different will be picking them up.
2. Turn in the completed medical form. **(Required to participate in camp activities.)**
3. If you ordered a t-shirt or would like one, pick it up at this time.
4. Say good bye to your camper for the day.

### Things you might want to know:

- ☆ Lunch is included in the price of the camp for 5-14 year olds. The camper has a choice of hamburger, hot dog, chicken strips, cheese pizza, or mini corn dogs served with fries, drink. (4-7 year olds will also get a snack)
- ☆ Your child should wear comfortable clothing and close toed shoes. Some activities do take place outside. Your child may want to bring a light jacket or sweatshirt.
- ☆ Your child may bring a camera.
- ☆ Your campers' name badge will also get them a 10% discount in the gift shop after the camp. You must accompany them. Stop by the information desk and leave your driver's license. You will be allowed 45 min. to shop.

### When you pick up your Camper(s) at Space Center Houston.....

**Pick up time:**

**4 year olds (11:30 a.m. morning session/ 3:30 p.m. Afternoon session)**

**5-14 year olds (3:30 p.m.),**


- ☆ Tell the toll booth attendant you are picking up a camper and the parking fee will be waived.
- ☆ Park in the main parking lot or in the lot just past the picnic area near the bus parking
- ☆ Proceed inside Space Center Houston's main entrance. Present your pick up card at the turnstiles for entrance. Continue on to the Silvermoon to pick up your camper.
- ☆ Your child will not be released to you until you have handed in the pick up card or signed him/her out. If someone else will be picking your child up, a picture ID must be shown, before your child will be released.
- ☆ **Aftercare campers** can be picked up at the information desk inside Space Center Houston. Any aftercare campers not picked up by 6:00 will be charged a \$15 late fee for every 15 min you are late.

## How to get to Space Center Houston



**FYI: NASA PARKWAY IS ALSO REFERRED TO AS NASA RD. 1.**

### FROM INTERSTATE 45:

*If coming from the north on I-45:*

Exit Bay Area Blvd continue on the feeder road till you reach the NASA parkway bypass. Take a left at the NASA parkway bypass. Follow the bypass until you reach Point Lookout drive and then take a left into the Space Center Houston entrance. Look for the two airplanes at the entrance.

*If coming from the south on I-45:*

Exit NASA Pkwy. Turn right at the NASA Parkway bypass. (Just past fry's electronics) Follow the bypass until you reach Point Lookout drive and then take a left into the Space Center Houston entrance. Look for the two airplanes at the entrance.

### FROM HIGHWAY 146

*If coming from the north on HWY 146:*



Turn right on NASA Pkwy. Continue down NASA Pkwy. Space Center Houston will be on the right just past NASA's Johnson Space Center.

*If coming from the south on HWY 146:*

Turn left on NASA Pkwy. Space Center Houston will be on the right hand side of NASA Pkwy.
