The center features more than 400 space artifacts, hands-on interactive educational exhibits, and robust youth programs interpreting the exciting future and remarkable past of America's human spaceflight program.

We are seeking adult volunteers to support the Guest Operations Department in the Saturn V Facility at Rocket Park. The volunteer will enhance the guest experience by providing information about the Saturn V Facility and other exhibits at Rocket Park. Responsibilities and qualifications are shown below:

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Engage individuals, school groups and families in tours of the Saturn V Facility.
- Educate the guests on the stages of the Saturn V Rocket and how the vehicle was used to transport astronauts to the moon and back.
- Provide information related to the Mercury, Gemini and/or Apollo programs and specifically the moon missions.
- Share knowledge about physics, engineering, astronaut training, mission objectives, spacecraft or hardware development, moon landings, or other topics related to the early years of the space program.
- Provide information to guests on how to return to Space Center Houston via the Tram.
- Interact and communicate with small and large groups of guests.
- May be called upon occasionally to assist with tours (behind the scenes) for VIP's, special visiting groups, etc.
- Maintain knowledge of current Space Center Houston attractions and exhibits.
- Log volunteer hours on a daily basis.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be age 18 years of age or older
- Prior knowledge of space exploration, aviation, or related work experience at NASA preferred.
- Must be professional and respectful in communicating with a diverse audience of guests representing a wide range of age groups and cultures.
- Strong presentation skills with the ability to speak to large groups.
- Must have ability to work independently, willing to take initiative, and be detail-oriented.
- Must be able to learn and effectively present materials provided in Volunteer Training Manual.
- Must be dependable and punctual.
- The ability to move about the facility for extended periods of up to 4 hours.

COMMITMENT

- At least one 4-hour shift per week.
- One year commitment to the volunteer program.
