- Working as part of a team on common duties to ensure the efficient operation of the area
- Responsible for proper flow of guests as they enter Space Center Houston and various attractions throughout the Center.
- Maintain a safe, clean and orderly work location.
- Accurately document hourly and daily reports.

- Weekend and holiday availability required.
