### POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the Education staff with Day Camp activities.
- Assist Education staff with Pop-Up Lab activities and provide assistance if guests require help.
- Provide welcoming, helpful, and friendly service to all guests.
- Direct guests to attractions in the Center as needed.

### POSITION QUALIFICATIONS

- Interest in space and/or science.
- Good interpersonal skills and the ability to interact with children and adults in a professional manner.
- Must be dependable.
- Must be available to work either of the following shifts:
  - 8:00 am-12:00
  - 12:00-4:00 pm
- Minimum commitment of two (2) days per week (1 shift per day) from June 4-August 17.
- Must be available to attend Orientation/Training session on Saturday, May 19<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 am-4:00 pm.

**Age:** Youth Volunteers must 15-17 years old.
