We are seeking a full time Projectionist. Responsibilities and qualifications are shown below:

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate, repair and maintain the Mission Briefing Center Theater operation including, but not limited to:
 - Pharoas lighting console, Yamaha TF-2 audio console, Barco E2 Switching console
 - Modern digital projector for live, pre-recorded, and remote programming
 - Ensure upkeep of projection room, 3D glasses washing room, and booth storage areas.
 - Be prepared for and participate in daily live shows by supporting on stage talent through an in-ear intercom. Provide immediate fact checking and document/pictorial/video resources for answers to guest questions.
- Perform troubleshooting and basic repair of equipment as needed.
- Perform administrative duties including, but not limited to:
 - Requisition supplies and equipment for maintenance, repair or replacement as approved by management;
 - Maintain inventory records and logs on all Mission Briefing Center Theater;
 - Ensure upkeep of projection room, washing room and booth storage areas.
- Work directly with internal and external clients to fulfill production requests in support of live programming, either directly or facilitating with Systems production staff depending on needs & complexity
- Demonstrates customer service by engaging theater guests as opportunities arise
- Assist the Systems Department in other areas of the facility
- Other duties as assigned.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS

- High school graduate/equivalent plus a minimum of 2 years experience with projection systems or equivalent experience in a technical field. Some hands-on studio or booth experience (particularly in a show environment) is preferred.
- Technical aptitude and willingness to learn the following: Audio Systems, Video Switching, Audio/Visual Presentation Set-up, Video Wall Programming, Show Control Programming, Lighting & Dimmer Control Systems, Video Production and Editing Systems, Uniview 3.0 Simulation Software
- Ability to work well under pressure and adapt to changing needs effectively.
- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to work and communicate well with all levels of the organization.
- Must have maturity to work with little or no supervision; must be trustworthy and dependable.
- Possess the ability to think clearly and quickly to make sound decisions under pressure situations.
