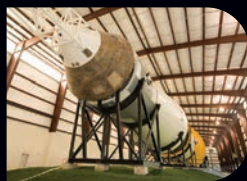


# Bringing people and space closer together

## NASA TRAM TOURS

Tour availability varies.



### Rocket Park

Visit George W.S. Abbey Rocket Park, where one of only three remaining Saturn V rockets is displayed, along with other rockets that propelled space exploration. 45 mins



### Astronaut Training Facility

Walk an elevated path through the Astronaut Training Facility where NASA astronauts train for current missions and NASA develops next-gen space vehicles. 60 mins



### Historic Mission Control - \$

Visit the iconic Christopher C. Kraft Mission Control Center and discover the Apollo Mission Control from which NASA led Gemini and Apollo missions. 60 mins



### NASA Campus Tour

Take a behind-the-scenes tram tour of NASA's Johnson Space Center for a rare glimpse of iconic landmarks, cutting-edge technology, and the future of space travel. 35 mins

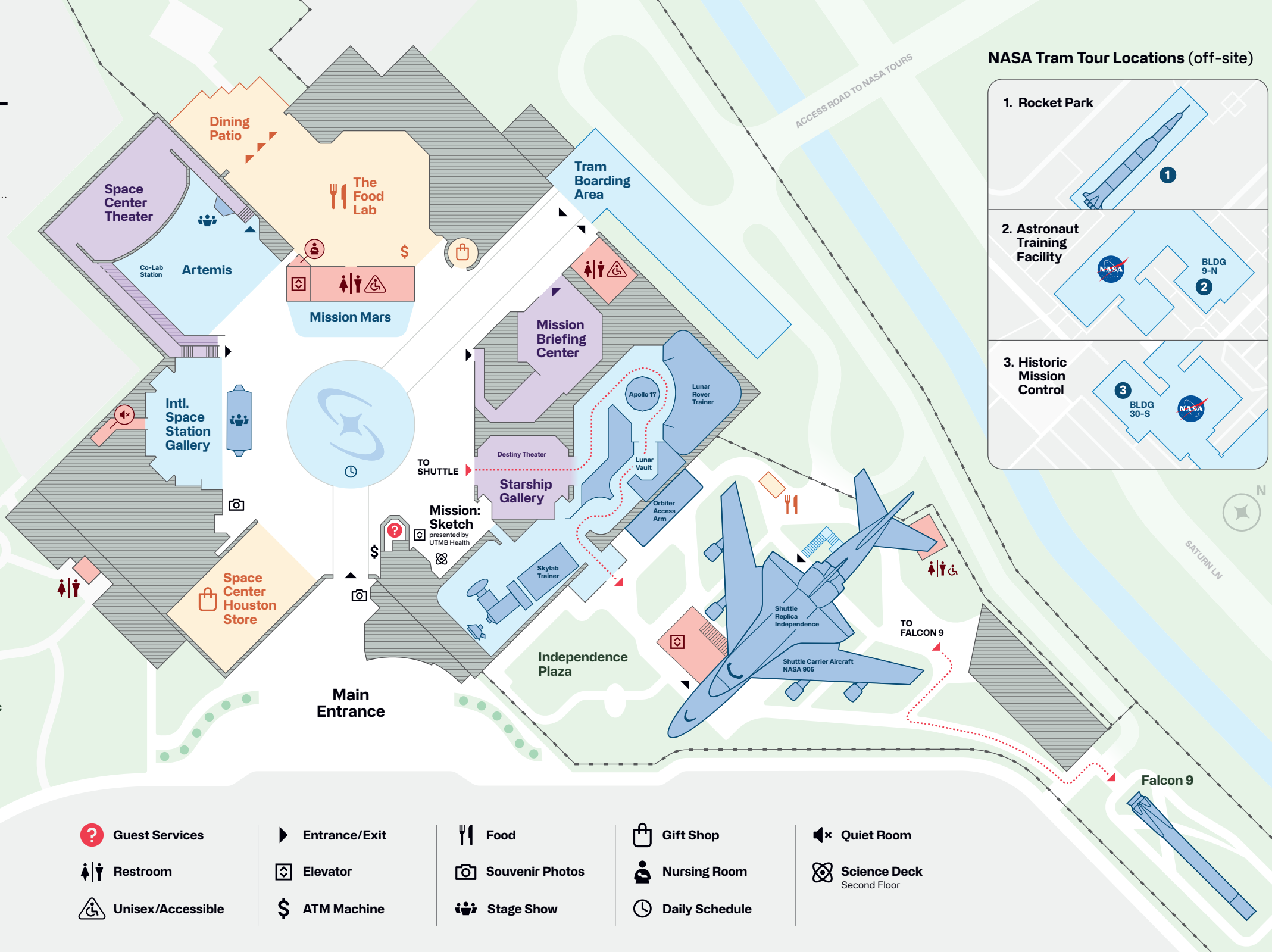
**Please note** that these are open-air tram tours. Tours may be interrupted due to inclement weather. The NASA Tram Tour visits working government facilities which are subject to availability.



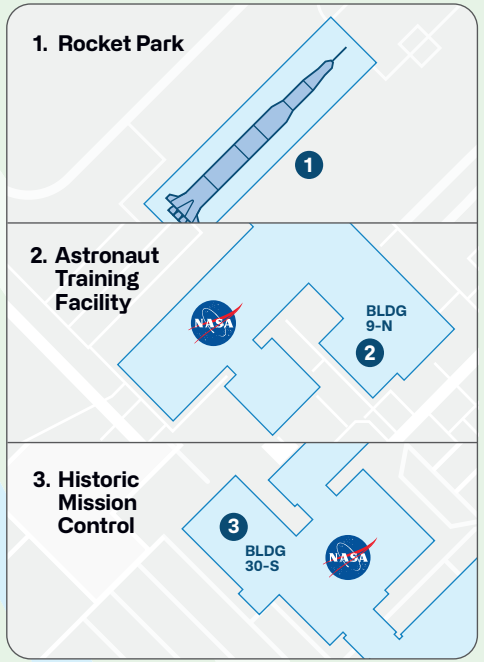
# Welcome to Space Center Houston

## FAQ

- **Visit the shuttle** by entering through Starship Gallery and exiting to Independence Plaza.
- **Visit the Falcon 9 rocket** by following the path beyond Independence Plaza, enter between the building and fence area.
- **Accessible entry** to plane, shuttle, Space Center Theater and Science Deck via elevators.
- **Need help?** Visit the Guest Services desk to the right of the main entrance or flag any SCH crew member in a blue shirt.
